Guardianship

We are proud that the Association for the Education and Guardianship of International Students (AEGIS) have given us their Gold award. We are also a recommended guardian service by the Boarding School Association (BSA). This means that you can be sure that we will give you an excellent service!

If you are sending your son or daughter to a UK boarding school, you will be asked to give the name of the someone in the UK who will be responsible for your child. Parents who do not have a friend or family member in the UK must use an accredited Guardianship organisation like us.

UK Guardians has only one level of service, as every child deserves only the best! We believe our service is very detailed and allows us to support our students in all parts of their life in the UK. We will do everything possible to support them and help them to have a great experience.

We make good relationships with your child's school, their homestay host, tutors and, of course, you as parents. We speak to the school about any questions or problems, and then contact you. You can also contact us any time!

Guardian Angels

Our 'guardian angels' are an important part of our programmes and guardianships. It is their job to support your child and guide them in the UK, to be their friend, and to help with any problems they have.

They will contact your child regularly to be sure that they are happy and to help them if needed. They will also visit your child in school and go to parents' evenings and school events.



Transport

We have UK Guardian drivers who will collect your child from the airport. The driver that collects your child from the airport is probably the first person they will meet from UK Guardians. They will be waiting with a smile!

- * You will be sent the driver's name and telephone number before arrival.
- * Our driver will not leave the airport without the student even if the flight is delayed.
- * All drivers are security checked and cleared to work with children, and are reliable and caring people who are fully insured with good quality vehicles.
- * The driver will take your child to the school or homestay host and introduce them before leaving.
- * On departures your driver will help you to check in at the desk and take you to the departure gate where he will say his goodbyes.





High School Year

Choose to study from 3 months up to 1 full year.

* **This programme is for EEA and EU students only**

On this programme, students fully experience British education and culture.

Students live with British homestay hosts and attend a UK school for up to one academic year. They will experience UK language and culture and make friends with many British students.

Our Guardian Angels support our students while they are in the UK. Students must show that they have good academic abilities and excellent behavior at all times.

While some schools still require students to wear a uniform, many have more relaxed dress codes for students aged 16+.

When students go back to their home countries, their 'normal' schools are often very impressed by the progress the student made in the UK. It's common for students to get higher grades than they did before their trip!

It is really good to see how these young people grow in confidence and maturity, and become more independent. Studying in the UK is a challenge, but a challenge made easier with the help of UK Guardians!

Summer Camps

Summer camps are the most exciting part of the summer, and we love them! Our camps happen in a modern university with residential accommodation, a canteen and great classrooms. And the location is just ten minutes from the world-famous beaches of Bournemouth!

Our summer camps are a fantastic mix of English language lessons, excursions, and activities. It is the perfect way for students to improve their English and explore the UK. Our summer camps run from the first week of July- to the last week August and each slot is a 2-week programme.

Excursions such as:

- * Jurassic Coast including Durdle Door
- * The historic town of Christchurch
- * New Forest National Park
- * Corfe Castle in Wareham
- * Highcliffe Castle in Christchurch
- * Hengistbury Head Nature Reserve

A variety of activities to suit every type of student, such as:

- * BBQ and salsa dancing
- * Movie night
- * Beach games
- * Shopping
- * Mini golf

Each 2-week programme includes:

- * Breakfast packed lunch and dinner
- * Residential accommodation with own bathroom
- * 18 taught hours of lessons per week
- * Breaks (on full teaching days) include: 30 minutes in the morning, 45 minutes at lunch and 15 minutes in the afternoon
- * 36 hours of excursions
- * Activities every evening
- * 24/7 support, including emergencies

Enrolment age: **12 years -21 years**

Maximum class size: **15 student**

Teaching

Our teaching has a focus on communication through pair work, group work, games, presentations, and more. This helps our students learn about and practise new vocabulary, grammar structures and pronunciation, and have fun at the same time.

Students are put in classes based on their age and level of English. Before arrival, we ask students to do a quick test to help us choose the best class for them.

All of our teachers are security checked, skilled professionals, and helped by an experienced Academic Manager. All our academic staff do their best to help students learn in a safe and fun environment.

Every student gets a report and certificate from their teacher at the end of their course with advice about how to keep improving their English when they get home.

Bespoke Groups

Our bespoke groups get a unique experience in their lessons as well as their trips and activities. Our teachers plan lessons to support your learners, their needs, and their interests. It's important to us that what students learn in the classroom can be used in the 'real world', so all of our lessons help students to practise their language with their homestay hosts and on their trips.

Summer Camps

Like our bespoke groups, lessons for Summer Camp students connect language to the 'real world'. Each lesson has a worksheet for each trip and activity students have on their programme to help with this. Students will often stay in the same class, with the same teacher, for their entire stay, which helps them to make new friends and enjoy their lessons. We want our students to go home having had the best summer of their lives!



Accommodation

Homestay

A real British family! Homestay hosts will welcome you into their home and they will provide you with meals and accommodation in a safe and caring environment. Our hosts are security checked and safe to host young people, and carefully selected to match students requirements. Many long-lasting friendships have developed over the years between homestay hosts and students that have had stayed in their homes.

There will be a maximum of 4 students with any homestay at a time. Shared rooms can be offered. Laundry is done weekly.

Residential

Our residential accommodation is available for some of our programmes and allows students to stay together in one place. We have a mixture of different types of rooms from shared bedrooms, to your very own bedroom with an en-suite bathroom.

We recommend all students bring enough clothes for the programme. However, students paid laundry facilities are available. With hosts and residential, bedding will be changed weekly.
